Fruit Cup Desert

19-ounce can of Pineapple (tidbits or chunks) – reserve juice

2 sliced Bananas

2 cups of Seedless Red Grapes (halved)

Reserved pineapple juice

3 Tbsp. Lemon Juice

4 Tbsp. Flour

2 Eggs

2/3 cup Sugar

Drain pineapple and place reserved juice into saucepan and combine with beaten eggs, lemon juice, sugar and flour. Cook over medium heat until thick. Combine all fruit in serving bowl and stir in cooled sauce and serve.
