Cake:

2 eggs
I 1/2 cups white sugar
2 tsp baking soda
I/2 tsp salt
I -14 oz can of fruit cocktail
2 cups fruit

Beat eggs, sugar, JUICE of fruit cocktail, baking soda, salt & flour Fold in fruit
Bake in greased 9x13 dish at 350 degrees for 45 minutes

Sauce:

3/4 cup sugar 1/2 cup cream 1/2 cup butter 1 tsp vanilla

Heat sugar, cream & butter in sauce pan. Bring to a boil, Remove from heat & add Vanilla.

Poke holes in cake & pour all sauce on hot cake.

"We wrapped up 2015 with numbers we haven't seen since 2007. This past year we saw 8,295 transactions on the Multiple Listing Service®, an increase of 23.8 per cent from last year."

A total of 465 properties sold in the Victoria Real Estate Board region this December, an increase of 19.5 per cent compared to the 389 properties sold in the same month last year.

ITEMS TO INCLUDE IN A BASIC EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT

Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking & sanitation. Food, at least a tree-day supply of non-perishable food

Battery-powered on hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both

Flashlight and extra batteries

First Aid Kit

Whistle to signal for help

Dust mask, to help alter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation

Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities

Can opener for food (if kit contains canned food)

Local maps, paper & pencil, Fire extinguisher, Matches in a waterproof container

Prescription medications and glasses, Feminine supplies & personal hygiene items Infant formula & diapers

Pet food & extra water for your pet

Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification & bank account records in a waterproof, portable container

Cash or traveler's cheques and change

Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person. Consider additional bedding if you live in cold weather climate

Complete change of clothes including long sleeve shirt, long pants & sturdy shoes. Consider additional clothing if you live in a cold climate

Household chlorine bleach & medicine dropper-when diluted 9 parts water to 1 part bleach can be used as disinfectant, Or treat water by using 16 drops regular household bleach per gallon of water, Don't use scented, color safe or bleaches with added cleaners.

Mess kits, paper cups, plates & plastic utensils, paper towels

Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children
